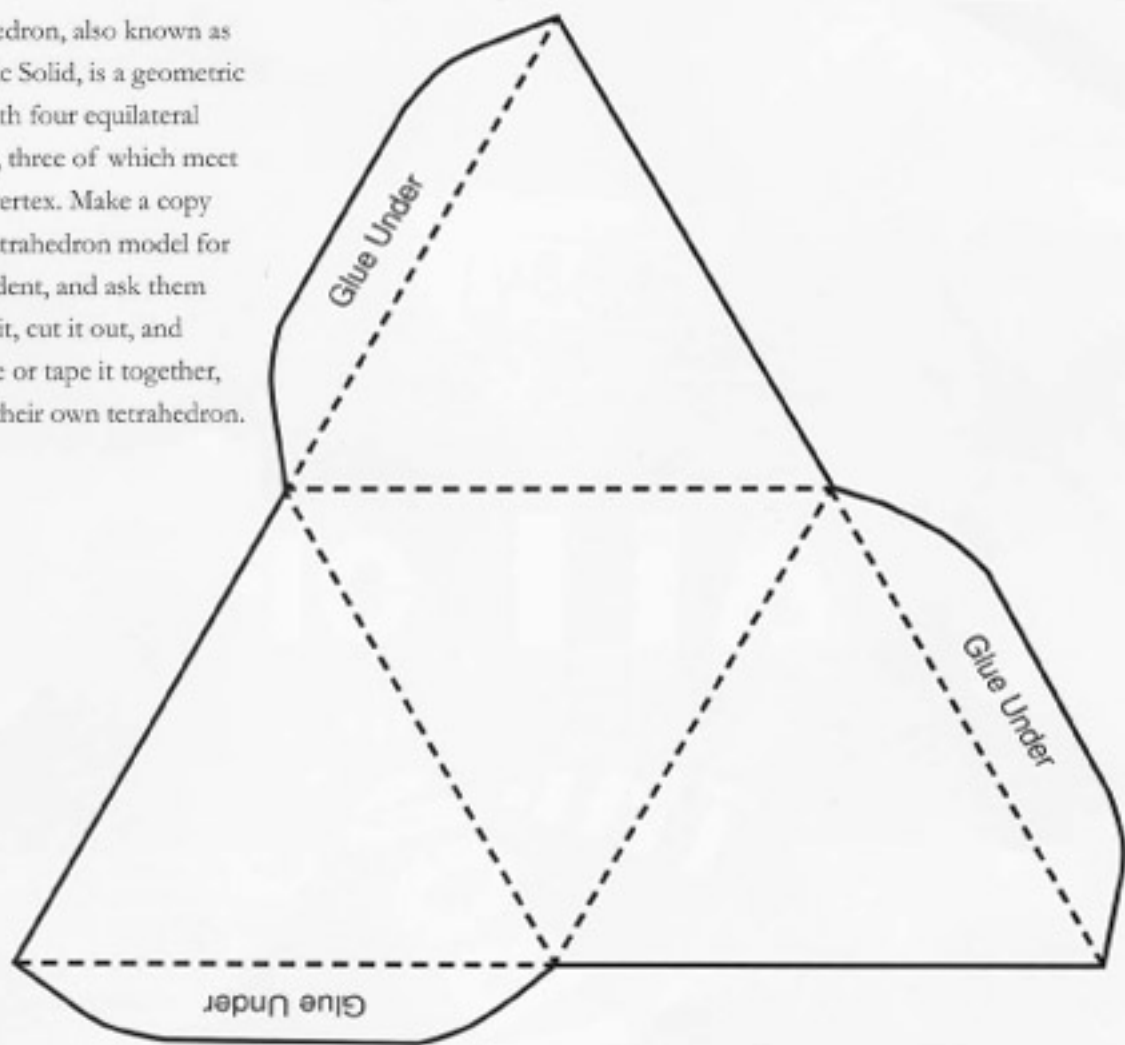


Pre-Reading Activities

A tetrahedron, also known as a Platonic Solid, is a geometric shape with four equilateral triangles, three of which meet at each vertex. Make a copy of the tetrahedron model for each student, and ask them to color it, cut it out, and then glue or tape it together, making their own tetrahedron.



Then, have the students tape their tetrahedrons together in sets of four to form larger tetrahedrons. These can be combined to form even larger tetrahedrons, if desired.
